Announcement from Board President Gerardo Rivera

Val Senegal to become the new Executive Director on April 1, 2025

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul Archdiocese of Galveston Houston (SVdP) is pleased to announce Val Senegal will become its Executive Director on April 1st. After a six-month national search, the committee and board of directors selected her to lead the Society into the future under the national theme "Adapting to a changing world." Val will step into the role after serving as SVdP's Chief Program Officer. Her guidance enabled the organization to successfully expand the Underserved Communities Initiative as well as enhance the Systemic Change Initiative: Getting Ahead Programs. Before joining the Society, she spent 20 years improving the lives of vulnerable populations in at-risk and distressed communities by addressing education, health, and social disparities.

Val assumes leadership from Ann Schorno who has served as SVdP's top executive for 15 years. Ann will remain with SVdP until May 31, 2025 to support Val during this transition. "I cannot thank Ann enough for her 15 years of tireless leadership and dedication to the Society. Under her guidance, the impact of SVdP in the Archdiocese more than doubled. While we will certainly miss her, we wish her the best as she embarks on the next chapter of her life," says Gerardo Rivera, Board President of SVdP. "I am excited that Val has accepted the opportunity to continue her service to the Society. Val exemplifies leadership, empowerment, and a commitment to positive change. The Board looks forward to working with Val and supporting her in this new role."

Val's career began with two years of service in AmeriCorps, and she brings two decades of experience working with local and national nonprofit organizations that address disparities and serve vulnerable populations, namely the University of Houston: Research Centers in Minority Institutions, Hearts of Hope: Sexual Trauma Center, United Way, National Area Health Education Centers, Junior League and Jack & Jill of America, Inc. Her determination and persistence have illuminated countless communities and secured the help for several families to overcome disasters across east Harris County. Her outlook on leadership draws inspiration because of her strong values and ethical beliefs. She believes success is embodied by a life aligned with one's purpose, commitment to excellence and rendering high-quality services to those in need. Her new leadership role will symbolize the exercising of innate talents to impact the lives of others. Val graduated with a bachelors degree from the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and obtained a Masters in Adult Education from Northwestern. In 2024, she received her executive leadership certification from Rice University's Glasscock School of Continuing Studies. She and her husband have three children, three godchildren, and a German Shepherd fur baby.

GAP ENROLLMENT UPDATE

We are excited to announce that we have started the **8th** cohort of the program! Here are some key details:

- Sessions Offered: 4 sessions were available for candidates to choose from.
- Enrollment: A total of 43 participants have enrolled.
- **Program Duration**: The program will run for 16 weeks, with weekly meetings focused on:
 - Understanding the causes of instability.
 - Researching available resources.
 - Building a supportive network.

Important Notes:

- Enrollment Period: The enrollment period for this cohort has now ended.
- Next Opportunity: Interested individuals can apply for the July sessions.

Desirable Characteristics for Program Candidates:

When referring neighbors into the program candidates for the program, prioritize the following characteristics:

- **Need**: Candidates should have a genuine need for support and improvement in their lives, but not in immediate crisis.
- Motivation: A strong desire to enhance their situation is essential.
- **Desire for Improvement**: Candidates must show a commitment to making positive changes.
- Ability to Utilize the Program: They should be capable of effectively using the resources and support provided by the program to create sustainable improvements.

Remember: Candidates choose the program; we do not choose for them.

- · Plants: Cover or bring inside to protect from frost damage.


