Distributed over 5.4 million pounds of food valued at \$10 million!

Helped 12,700 families with rent & utilities totaling \$3.4 million in financial assistance!



Provided \$1.6 million in financial relief to over 1,100 families affected by the pandemic.

\$250,000 in other financial needs such as tuition, transportation, medical, funeral, and other needs.

WHAT YOU SUPPORT

- **HOME VISITS:** Visiting our friends-in-need helps the Society identify the most pressing needs of the poor to be able to render assistance.
- **VINCENTIAN SERVICE CENTER:** Our 50,000 square foot facility accomodating the operations of the programs providing food, clothing, and furniture. It also serves as the hub for disaster relief response.
- **FOOD NETWORK:** Operates from within the VSC, receiving and delivering pallets of food to our 22 community-based food pantries. During the pandemic, the food network set up pop-up food drives in several underserved communities.
- **RESALE SHOPS, CLOTHING & FURNITURE VOUCHERS:** Clothing and furniture vouchers go hand-in-hand with our resale shops. The shops give our friends the opportunity to redeem their vouchers, select their own clothing or furniture, and carry out the transaction with dignity.
- **DISASTER RELIEF HUB:** Transforms into central location for receiving and distributing food, financial, and in-kind donations.
